

HISTORICAL PERSEPECTIVE

The Education Foundation of Baltimore County Public Schools, Inc. is an independent organization created under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code in support of quality education for all children.

Organized on October 26, 1992, as the Baltimore County Public Schools Education Foundation, it was to attract and direct public financial contributions to programs and activities of the school system in support of quality education for all children.

In 2013, the name was changed to The Education Foundation of Baltimore County Public Schools, Inc.
